

## Children's Activities Volunteer

### Where will it be?

Hartlebury Castle

### How much time will you need to give?

This opportunity will take place on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Thursdays during school holidays and Bank Holiday weekends.

Ideally, we like our volunteers to do at least one day within each school holiday. We would prefer volunteers to do a full session, 10.30am-4pm, but also welcome volunteers to join us for half-days - either 10.30am-1pm or 1-4pm.

### What will you be asked to do?

As a Children's Activities Volunteer you will supervise fun and creative art and craft activities, these include mask making, painting, clay models, pumpkin carving, making Christmas decorations and many more.

All children (5-10) will be accompanied by an adult, your task will be to explain the activity and help whilst the children have a go. There would also be an opportunity to help plan and prepare the activities in advance.

All volunteers will receive full instructions and materials from our Learning and Events Team and be shown what to do before being let loose to help our younger visitors.

### Why do we need this role?

Our holiday activities are an important part of the visitor experience at Hartlebury. We need volunteers to make sure these activities run smoothly and ensure our young visitors have a fantastic day to remember.

### Skills you will need

If you are friendly, welcoming and enjoy being part of a team then you are just who we are looking for.

Volunteers need to be:

- Happy to work alone and as part of a team
- Confident, friendly and polite
- Good with children (essential)
- Creative (desirable but not essential)
- Reliable

### Other things to consider

Refreshments will be available to volunteers during their session and those staying for a full day will have an opportunity to take a lunch break.
