How much time will you need to give?

What will you be asked to do?

As an Events and Activities Volunteer you will help us prepare and delivery fun and engaging children's holiday activities. These include mask making, painting, potion making, Christmas decorations and many, many more.

For our activities, children (aged 4+) will be accompanied by an adult, your role will be to explain the activity and watch over the children whilst they take part.

You will support our big events, such as Living History, by helping welcome and orientate visitors in a friendly and polite manner. Also, you will help musicians/actors and speakers and generally keep events running smoothly.

Why do we need this role?

Our events and holiday activities are an important part of what we offer at The Commandery. This role is needed to make sure everything runs well and ensures visitors have a wonderful experience.

Skills you will need

We welcome interest from anyone 18 years and over, regardless of background or experience.

In this role it would be beneficial to have experience of supervising children.

- A good communicator
- Well organised
- Reliable
