Why do we need this role?

As part of the <u>Portable Antiquities Scheme</u> in partnership with Birmingham Museums Trust, we are looking for a volunteer to handle and record real archaeological finds.

The right person will be given the chance to develop their archaeological interests and contribute to the largest Community Archaeology project in the country.

How much time will you need to give?

This opportunity will take place on Wednesdays, in the daytime.

Ideally, we would be looking for someone who can volunteer weekly.

What will you be asked to do?

- Editing images of our archaeological finds using Photoshop
- Photographing new objects
- Updating our database with new records and photographs

Skills you will need:

- Background in Archaeology (academic or practical experience)
- Computer literate
- Able to take good quality digital photographs
- Good attention to detail
- Happy to work independently
- Reliable and committed to volunteering regularly
