GROUNDS & GARDENS

Relax in the peaceful grounds of Hartlebury Castle as you stroll around the historic moat. Get back to nature as you encounter the Castle's wildlife, take in the floras' colours of the seasons and discover the 280 year old mulberry tree. Explore the nature trail, spot the hidden painted animals and let off steam on our adventure playground. The open spaces are perfect for children to run around in and enjoy outdoor games.



FUN FOR FAMILIES

Experience a great day out for all the family, with hands-on displays, dressing up stations and secret rooms. Explore the palace with the children's audio guide and discover the exciting adventure playground, as you balance on ropes and beams, slide down from the towers and have a go on the zip wire.

The Castle is pushchair friendly, however access to parts of the grounds may be restricted. There is level access to the playground. Baby changing facilities can be found across the site.



WORCESTERSHIRE COUNTY MUSEUM

Explore the history of Worcestershire through fascinating museum collections including toys, costume, archaeology and agriculture. Step back to Victorian times in the schoolroom and scullery, take a tour of the 1950s in the Lavish Living exhibition and enjoy three centuries of fashion in Captivating Costume - from the extravagant frocks of the Georgians to the miniskirts of the 1960s.
