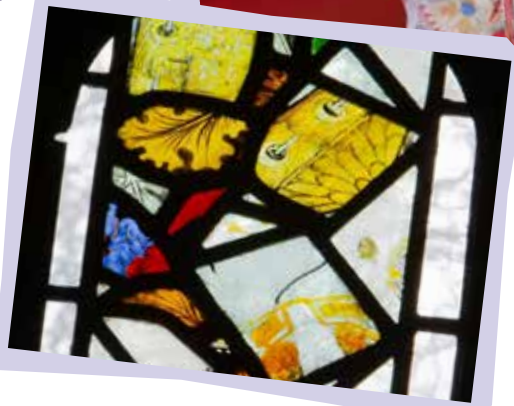




Play Guide

“How could a Georgian person dance?”

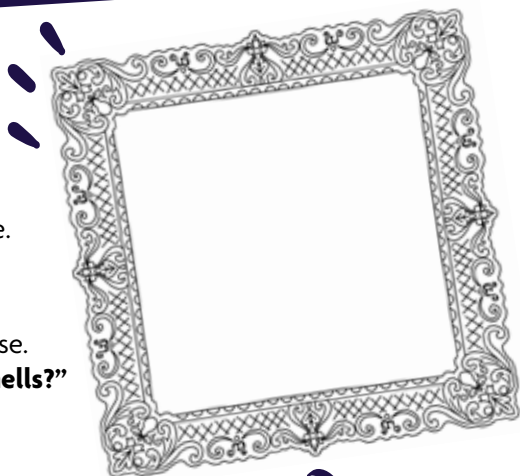
Try the dressing up areas and strike a pose.

The accessible bathroom contains baby change facilities. The lift is available and pushchairs are welcome throughout The Commandery.

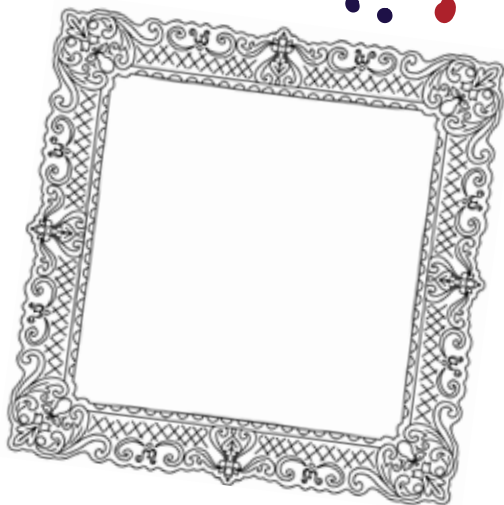
Outside The Commandery
